


FOLD AND TAPE HERE

- 1. Cut a circle through the stem end or bottom of the pumpkin for your cap.
- 2. Use a large spoon to scoop out the seeds and pulp.

- 3. Trim pattern along dotted line. Crease lines and tape onto pumpkin. Make sure pattern is flat against the surface.
 4. Trace design by poking holes with a sharp awl or needle tool then remove pattern.
 5. Cut along the dotted line of your pattern. Push the cut-out, dark gray features gently from the inside of the pumpkin.



FOLD AND TAPE HERE

- Cut out pattern along dotted line. Cease lines and tape on to the part of the pumpkin you want to carve.
 Trace design by poking holes with a sharp awl or needle tool then remove pattern.
 Cut along the dotted line of your pattern and cut out dark grey areas of the pattern.
 Push the cut-out features gently from the inside of the pumpkin and discard the pieces.

- 7. Place a candle or LED light inside the pumpkin to create an eerie glow.


